2006 METROBANK FOUNDATION SEARCH FOR OUTSTANDING TEACHERS

To: **Bureau Directors**

Regional Directors

Private Elementary and Secondary Schools Principals

- The Metrobank Foundation, Inc. (MBFI), in cooperation with the Department of Education (DepEd), announces the launching of the Search for Outstanding Teachers 2006. Now on its 22nd year, the Search has awarded a total of 246 outstanding teachers from public and private schools all over the country.
- 2. The Search bestows honor upon the teaching profession by according special recognition to teachers who manifest profound commitment to the development of the youth through exemplary competence, remarkable dedication to their work and effective educational leadership. It singles out teachers who have made a significant contribution to national development by raising the quality of outcomes of education through their effective, innovative and creative teaching strategies, materials and devices and their admirable efforts to bring the school closer to the community and consequently, the community to the school, thereby providing models of excellence in the teaching profession.
- The Search is open to all teachers with full-time status and with full load in the elementary and secondary schools, who have been actively teaching in the Philippines for the last 10 years (inclusive of leaves not exceeding two years, provided it is not during the nomination period). For both elementary and secondary categories, the basic educational requirement is bachelor's degree. Performance ratings should at least be "Very Satisfactory" for the last five (5) years.
- Each school is entitled to one nominee for each category and nominees must be officially endorsed by principals, head teachers or school heads, who are the only ones authorized to nominate teachers to the Search. For DepEd Schools without principals, the Teacher-in-Charge

(TIC) can nominate, but the Schools Division/City Superintendent (SDS) must endorse the nomination. Head Teachers (HTs), TICs and Assistant Principals are eligible to join the Search, provided they carry a teaching load of at least 50% of the total load required by the nominating school for full-time faculty. However, they should be endorsed by any of the Division Supervisors, and the SDS concerned should be the official nominators.

- 5. The nominators are required to accomplish and sign the nomination forms with the complete required attachments (one original copy and three (3) photocopies with attached original 2x2 colored photos) and submit them directly or send them by registered mail to Metrobank Foundation, 15th Floor, Metrobank Plaza, Sen. Gil J. Puyat Avenue, Makati City, or to any Metrobank Branch nearest to the nominee's school. "Please do not send the supporting documents vet". The deadline for submission of the nomination forms shall be on or before February 14, 2006. Nominations sent by mail should be postmarked on or before the same date.
- 6. Starting 2006, winners of other searches for outstanding teachers at the city/provincial/division/regional/national/international levels are deemed automatic second-round qualifiers, provided they meet the basic eligibility requirements of tenure, performance and teaching load. They must also go through the usual nomination process and submit the duly-accomplished nomination forms and required attachments on or before the deadline.
