2005 GINTONG ILAWAN EDUCATOR'S AWARD PROGRAM (Ten Outstanding Female Private Elementary School Principals)

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Private Elementary School Principals

- 1. The Department of Education in partnership with Avon is launching the New Gintong Ilawan Teodora Alonso Educator's Award Program. This program is jointly sponsored by the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (FAPE).
- 2. As the awards program celebrates its 17th year of commitment to recognize exemplary educators, it will now honor not only one (1) National Winner but Ten (10) Outstanding Female Principals. The criteria for evaluation and the manner of selection basically remain the same. The new elements are as follows:
 - a. The Regional Director, the Chief of Elementary and Head/Representative of FAPE will sit en banc to determine two (2) candidates from the Region who will be nominated to form part of the National Shortlist.
 - b. The National Shortlist which consists of two (2) nominees from all 17 regions (34), will be reviewed by a National Selection Committee. Their output is a list of 17 names.
 - c. The documents of the 17 principals will be reviewed by the National Board of Judges who will be tasked with identifying this year's Ten Outstanding Female Principals.
 - d. The ten winners will be notified and be invited to come to Manila to attend a two-day AIM Management Training Program in April. Their prizes will be awarded on the second evening of the Training Program to coincide with the AIM Graduation.
- 3. As in previous years, awards will alternate among public and private elementary and secondary categories.
- 4. All Division Superintendents are requested to submit at least a Division Candidate to the Regional Screening Committee.

- 5. Regional Directors are requested to coordinate with the Gintong Ilawan National Secretariat, the Avon and FAPE representatives by leading the team that will determine the Regional Nominees and assigning their Chiefs of Elementary to give full support to the program.
- 6. Enclosed is the Application Form 2005.
- 7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
