## FIRST DEPED-MTAP NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON MATHEMATICS EDUCATION

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. The Department of Education (DepED) and the Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines (MTAP), will conduct the **First DepED-MTAP National Conference on Mathematics Education** on May 3-6, 2006 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City with the theme "Strengthening Teachers' Role in Mathematics Education".
- 2. The conference aims to:
  - enhance the knowledge and skills of elementary and secondary school heads and mathematics teachers to produce graduates who are independent and life-long learners;
  - b. strengthen the commitment of mathematics teachers to their vocation as molders of the youth;
  - c. respond to the drive for academic reforms, specifically on the new assessment approaches, suggest programs and do strategies that will bridge the elementary and secondary curricula; and
  - d. establish a national network for mathematics teachers towards excellence in mathematics education.
- 3. The participants in the conference are principals of elementary/secondary public and private schools; regional, division and district supervisors involved in mathematics teaching, elementary and secondary schools mathematics teachers.
- 4. A registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP3,500.00) shall be charged each participant to cover travel, honoraria and board and lodging of resource persons, meals (from lunch of May 3 to breakfast of May 6, 2006), lodging, conference materials, certificates of attendance and participation, conference bag and miscellaneous expenses. Registration fees and travel expenses of each participant shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Members of the different working committees are authorized to travel one or two days before the conference according to the need.

- 6. A refundable reservation fee of Five Hundred Pesos (PhP500.00), a pre-condition of Teachers Camp organizers, is required on or before January 30, 2006. Participation is on first-come, first-served basis. The organizers cannot guarantee a place to any interested person who do not reserve on or before the indicated date.
- 7. The reservation fee of Five Hundred Pesos (PhP500.00) is to be deposited to the MTAP Account No. 540-7540504241 in any Metrobank branch and the deposit slip to be sent through fax to no. (02) 912-5249 indicating the name and address of the depositor and branch of Metrobank.
- 9. More detailed information and an application form will be sent to all who make the reservation fee. Any clarification may be made at telefax no. (02) 912-5249.
