GO NEGOSYO SUMMIT AND YECS AND STEP ANNUAL PLANNING AND EVALUATION CONFERENCE

To: Regional Directors

- 1. The Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA) personnel and staff together with the Regional Education Supervisors/Coordinators of Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) will attend the GO NEGOSYO Summit on February 22-24, 2006 at the Market! Market!, The Fort, Taguig City and conduct the YECS and STEP Annual Evaluation and Planning Conference on February 24-27, 2006 at the Boso Boso Highlands Hotel and Resort, Antipolo City, These activities are in pursuant to DepED Order No. 73, s. 2003 entitled Strengthening the Student Technologists and Entrepreneurs of the Philippines (STEP) to Enhance the Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) of the Basic Education Curriculum (BEC), DepED Order No. 55, s. 2002 entitled the Revitalized Youth Entrepreneurship and Cooperativism in Schools (YECS) Program, and DepED Order No. 56, s. 2005 entitled the Revised Implementing Guidelines on the Operation of the Youth Entrepreneurship and Cooperativism in Schools Program.
- 2. The GO NEGOSYO Summit is organized by the Philippine Center for Entrepreneurship led by Presidential Consultant on Entrepreneurship Joey A. Concepcion. It aims to:
 - a. put under one roof a simulation of the entrepreneurship eco-system which supports entrepreneurship in all critical stages of the entrepreneurs' life cycle (education, ideas-generation, business planning, seeding, strat-up, expansion, and divestment);
 - demystify and popularize the essentials of entrepreneurial success to increase the level of awareness on entrepreneurship as a career of choice among the youth;
 - c. expose and help entrepreneurship educators teach entrepreneurship effectively; and,
 - d. encourage entrepreneurial start-ups and create an environment that fosters seamless cooperation among key players in the eco-system supporting and nurturing the growth of entrepreneurship.
- 3. The YECS and STEP Annual Evaluation and Planning Conference aims to achieve the following objectives:
 - evaluate the YECS and STEP programs, including the conduct of the 4th STEP-National Skills Development and Competition (NSDC) held on November 19-24, 2005 in General Santos City:
 - b. identify and resolve issues and concerns pertinent to the YECS and STEP implementation:
 - c. plan and agree on the thrusts and activities of the YECS and STEP for the coming School Year;
 - d. plan for the conduct of the 5th STEP-NSDC which will include the review and revision of the contest rules and guidelines of the skills

competition in accordance with the various feedbacks during the 4th STEP-NSDC, and the identification of the skills to be competed during the different levels of competitions;

- e. assess and discuss ways to improve the participation of the elementary level in the STEP-NSDC; and,
- f. plan for the conduct of the YECS Entrepreneurship Training.
- 4. Participants to this evaluation and planning conference are the Regional TLE Supervisors in-charge of the YECS and STEP programs or their authorized representatives, members of the STEP National Executive Committee and the Secretariat from the Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA). Enclosed is the list of participants to the conference.
- 5. Participants are expected to be at the venue before dinner of February 22, 2006. The CSCA shall only shoulder board and lodging beginning dinner of February 22, 2006 until breakfast of February 27, 2006.
- 6. Travel expenses and other incidental expenses of participants shall be charged against local funds. Expenses for board and lodging, supplies and materials shall be shouldered by the DepED-CSCA. All expenses to be incurred relative to these activities are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
