NATIONAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT AND MONITORING PROGRAM  
ON ICT IN BASIC EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents  
Heads, Public Secondary Schools

1. The Department of Education (DepED), through the Bureau of Secondary Education-Curriculum Development Division (BSE-CDD) will conduct the National Impact Assessment and Monitoring Program on ICT in Basic Education. This activity shall be done in collaboration with the Partners in Learning (PiL) through: (a) the Philippine Normal University (PNU); (b) Cebu Normal University (CNU); (c) University of the Immaculate Conception (UIC); (d) Southeastern College, Pasay City; (e) CEFTEX, Cebu; (f) the Philippine Business for Social Progress (PBSP); (g) Softrigger Solutions, QSense; and, (g) the Learn.ph Foundation.

2. This assessment and monitoring program activity aims to gather relevant and quantifiable data on the impact and benefits of ICT in basic education to students and teachers in particular and to the community in general. This, in turn, will help fine-tune future ICT integration into the Basic Education Curriculum.
