2006 SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAMS OF THE BUREAU OF SECONDARY EDUCATION (BSE)

- 1. The Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) announces its summer training programs for CY 2006. The training programs are designed to:

Registration fees and traveling expenses of participants shall be charged against local funds while board and lodging, traveling and other incidental expenses of training staff shall be charged against BSE funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
