AWARDING CEREMONY FOR THE NATIONAL SEARCH FOR THE MOST EFFECTIVE PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS IN MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE

- 1. The awarding ceremony of the Search for the Most Effective Public Elementary Schools in Mathematics and Science will be held on March 23, 2006, 1:30 p.m. at the Bulwagan ng Karunungan, Department of Education, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City.
- 2. The highest ranking central and non-central schools in the two learning areas will be adjudged as the Most Effective Elementary School in Mathematics and Science for SY 2004-2005. Likewise, the first and second runners-up shall also be awarded. Special awards shall be given to the top three highest ranking schools per learning area (excluding the schools which were declared Grand Winners and Runners-up) in both categories and shall be declared as Best in Mathematics and Best in Science.
- 3. The grand winners in both categories (central and non-central) will each receive Presidential Trophy, Certificates of Recognition and other valuable prizes. Likewise, the first and second runners-up in both categories will also be awarded with trophies and Certificates of Recognition and other valuable prizes. Special awards shall be given Certificates of Recognition.
- 4. The Regional Director, Schools Division Superintendent, District Supervisor, Principal and a representative from the Teacher organization of the national finalists are invited to attend the awarding ceremony.
