NATIONAL WORK-CONFERENCE OF CHIEFS AND ASSISTANT CHIEFS
OF ELEMENTARY EDUCATION TOWARDS HIGH
PERFORMANCE IN ENGLISH

1. The *National Work-Conference of Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of Elementary Education Towards High Performance in English* shall be held on April 24-28, 2006 at the Bayview Park Hotel, Roxas Boulevard corner United Nations Avenue, Manila. This activity shall be hosted by the National Capital Region (NCR).

2. Focusing on the theme "*Creating Synergy Towards High Performance in English*", the work-conference aims to:

- a. share documented interventions in "Every Child A Reader Program" (ECARP) that contributed to improved reading performance;
- b. design an integrated Monitoring and Evaluation Program for ECARP; and
- c. enhance teamwork and networking between and among regions and the bureau.

3. The participants to this work-conference are the Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of Elementary Education Division of the seventeen (17) regions, the Director, Assistant Director, Division Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE). One (1) Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) implementing the ECARP chosen by the region shall also participate in the conference.
