
FIRST NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON THE EDUCATION OF CHILDREN
WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DELAYS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. The Department of Education through the Special Education Division-Bureau of Elementary Education (SPED-BEE) in collaboration with the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) and the Philippine Association for the Retarded (PAR) will hold the First National Orientation Convention on the Education of Children with Developmental Delays at the Teachers Camp, Baguio City on May 15-17, 2006. Prof. Kaors Yamaguchi, an international speaker and expert on developmental delays will be the keynote speaker.
2. With the theme "Building the Possibilities", the conference aims to provide participants the opportunity to:
 - a. gain an understanding of current knowledge on developmental delays and its implication to research for educational intervention;
 - b. explore current and innovative strategies on the education of children with developmental delays;
 - c. enhance the instructional competence and managerial skills of teachers, administrators in handling children with developmental delays; and
 - d. create synergy among teachers, parents, administrators and professionals on the implementation of programs/services for children with developmental delays.
3. Special education and regular teachers, school administrators from public/private elementary/secondary schools, education supervisors in SPED at the division and regional offices of the elementary education divisions, schools division superintendents, assistant superintendents and OAS scholars are expected to participate on official business.
4. Specialists on the education of children with developmental delays are invited to present papers. The Presenter Information Form and Sample Abstract Form are found in Enclosure Nos. 2A and B. These should be submitted on or before April 2, 2006. The program of activities and topics for presentation are found in Enclosure No. 1.

5. A registration fee of Four Thousand Pesos (PhP4,000.00) shall be charged to live-in participants which shall include board and lodging for three days, conference kits, handouts and certificates. Pre-registration is encouraged to facilitate the preparation of materials (Enclosure No. 3). All inquiries may be addressed to: Ms. Mirla R.
