1. The Philippine Association of Secondary Education Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs, (PASECAC) in collaboration with the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) of the Department of Education, announces the schedule of the quarterly conferences and the presentation of the research reports by different regions in the following venues and dates:

 - d. visit selected secondary schools that implement variety of innovations.

The participants in the conference are the Secondary Education Division Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of the 16 DepED regions, the BSE Director of ARMM, the Director, Assistant Director, Chief/Assistant Chief of the Curriculum Development Division (CDD), the Officer-in-Charge of the Staff Development Division (SDD) and two Education Program Specialists of BSE.
