55TH ANNUAL STAFF DEVELOPMENT SEMINAR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION DENTISTS ASSOCIATION (DEDA)

- 1. The Department of Education Dentists Association (DEDA) in coordination with the Department of Education-Health and Nutrition Center (DepED-HNC), will hold its 55th Annual Staff Development Seminar on April 26-28, 2006, at Villa Lorenza, Pililla, Rizal with the theme "DEDA: Conquering New Heights In Oral Health Care for Improved Learning".
- 2. The seminar aims to enhance the capabilities of dentists towards a more rational delivery of dental services to schools. Specifically, this activity will:
