**CERTIFICATE PROGRAM FOR HIGH SCHOOL NON-MAJOR TEACHERS
 OF SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS**

To: Regional Directors
 Schools Division/City Superintendents
 Heads, Public Secondary Schools

1. Cognizant of the important role the teacher plays in the teaching learning process, the Department, through the Bureau of Secondary Education and the Regional Offices, in partnership with the Department of Science and Technology, through the Science Education Institute, announces the **Certificate Program for High School Non-major Teachers of Science and Mathematics**, which shall be conducted beginning this Summer, 2006.
2. The certificate program seeks to improve the capability of teachers who are non-majors or minors in science and mathematics by equipping them with knowledge of content, strategies in teaching and tools for assessing learning. Follow-through interventions at the Division level are expected to be provided during the semestral break as part of the continuing capability-building of teachers.
3. The Certificate Program is a 24-unit program leading to a minor in the sciences or mathematics. It shall be a six-week course and shall run for two (2) summers. **The first term of summer classes shall begin on April 17, 2006 and end on May 27, 2006.**
4. The initial batch of participants shall undergo the program at the Regional Science Teaching Centers (RSTCs) or the CHED's Centers of Excellence (COEs) in the regions. The RSTCs are listed by regions in the enclosed Summary Table of Data.
5. The participants identified by the Division shall present the following requirements for admission: *Permit to study* and the undergraduate *Transcript of Records (TOR)* upon entry to the RSTC/COE. Should they fail to present these credentials, they will only be given *Certificate of Participation* at the end of the course.
6. Each participant shall receive Php12,000 stipend and Php2,000 book allowance per summer training, which shall be channeled through the RSTC/COE where he/she is enrolled. For further information please contact Ms. Bella O. Mariñas at telefax nos. 632-7586.
