NATIONAL TRAINING-WORKSHOP ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE REDESIGNED TECHNICAL-VOCATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Technical-Vocational High Schools

1. The Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), this Department shall conduct the National Training Workshop on the Implementation of the Redesigned Technical-Vocational High School Program in two (2) clusters, as follows:

- 2. The training aims to:
 - a. consolidate best practices from the first year of implementation;
 - b. orient participants on the integration of 1) FRESH concept in the implementation of technical-vocational program and 2) reading and writing, science, values education, ICT and entrepreneurship skills into the different vocational courses; and
 - c. apply appropriate methods/strategies in integrating the concepts in teaching and in materials development.
- 3. The participants in the said activity are the School Heads, Department Heads, and Teachers of Technical-Vocational Secondary Schools who implemented the Year 1 of the redesigned curriculum, TLE/TVE Regional Supervisors and Division Supervisors. The participants are expected to be at the venue on the afternoon of Day 0 (May 7, 2006) for Cluster I and (May 21, 2006) for Cluster II of the training. Likewise, the first meal shall be served during dinner of Day 0.
- 4. Registration fee, traveling expenses, and per diem of the participants shall be charged against local/school funds, while those of the training staff, honorarium of resource persons, board and lodging, transportation, and other incidental expenses relative to the training shall be charged against BSE Project Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
