BIBO BOHOL ECO-CULTURAL HERITAGE IMMERSION AND AWARENESS PROGRAM 2006

- 1. The Bohol Arts and Cultural Heritage Council (BACH), in collaboration with the Provincial Government of Bohol, the Metropolitan Museum of Manila, the City Government of Tagbilaran, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD Region VII), the Department of Education, DepED Bohol Division, DepED Tagbilaran City Division, the Holy Name University in Tagbilaran City, the Department of Social Welfare and Development, Council for the Welfare of Children, Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Girl Scouts of the Philippines, and the National Commission for Culture and the Arts is pleased to announce the conduct of the Bibo Bohol Heritage Awareness Summer Program 2006, which will consist of the following main activities:
 - a. International Conference on Heritage Houses and Vernacular Architecture on May 16-17, 2006, in Tagbilaran City; and
 - b. Bibo Bohol Eco-Cultural Heritage Summer Camp for Students and Youths May 18-21, 2006 in Bilar, Bohol.
- 2. The Summer Program is a cluster of projects designed to:
 - a. raise the awareness of Filipino youth, students and teachers on the values and significance of the country's rich ecological and cultural heritage;
 - b. demonstrate the potentials of heritage for enriching cultural identity, social development and economic livelihood for poverty reduction, as an important component for sustainable development; and
 - c. equip teachers and cultural educators with additional knowledge and skills in the preparation of interactive, integrative and interdisciplinary modules for the different subject areas (social studies and ecological/cultural heritage education, especially for Araling Panlipunan and Arts and Music subjects, etc.).

- 3. Enclosed are the details of the various events.
- 4. The Eco-Cultural Heritage Camp will be assisted by a Support Coordinating Team from the DepED Central Office, composed of Ms. Alice Pańares (NEAP), Mr. Joey Pelaez (CSCA) and Ms. Lilian Luna (SPA).
- 5. Participating teachers are expected to submit a report of their participation with their lesson exemplars based on their enhanced knowledge and skills on heritage education, one (1) week after the conduct of the activities attended to by the DepED Support Coordinating Team.
- 6. Registration fees and transportation expenses of participating DepED officials, teachers and students shall be charged to their local funds/local school board funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
