

**URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION  
(DepEd) AND THE COMMISSION ON HIGHER  
EDUCATION (CHED) TO CONDUCT ENGLISH  
PROFICIENCY ASSESSMENTS FOR ALL TEACHERS  
IN BOTH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS IN THE  
COUNTRY.**

**WHEREAS**, it has been reported that there is an English proficiency crisis in the Philippines at present. Fewer Filipinos could now speak English fluently since schools began using local dialects as their medium of instruction,

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to improve English proficiency of the coming generation to enable the country to capture a larger share of the booming call center market in the Philippines but out of every one hundred (100) call center applicants, only five (5) or ten (10) got accepted because of English non-proficiency,

**WHEREAS**, this deficiency may be attributed to the fact that the quality of education the students receive depends largely on the skill and competence of the teachers, hence, any attempt to solve the English proficiency crisis in the Philippines must start with the teachers;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to assess the teachers in public and private schools in the country and if possible, the government will give a mandatory training for the teachers, who have low scores in English proficiency assessment, for the improvement of English communicative skills;

**WHEREAS**, a study conducted by two researchers of the University of the Philippines in the Visayas - Cebu College (UPV - CC) concluded that high school teachers need more training in Sexuality Education (SE);

**WHEREAS**, the researchers identified the following problems on teaching the subject, namely the negative responses among the students, the lack of instructional materials and equipment, as well as the insufficient knowledge or mastery of the teachers on the subject matter;

**WHEREAS**, Sexuality Education or Health subjects are very useful to high school students since it is everybody's concern in the school environment. Sex and sexuality are the major curiosities among the youth, yet the access to right information is inadequate because of insufficient instructional materials and knowledge of teachers in handling the subject;

**WHEREAS**, the worries about the pre-marital sex, virginity and pregnancy are the concerns among the female youth various ages;

**WHEREAS**, Sexuality Education (SE) or Health subjects will guide high school students to face these problems that they will encounter throughout their teenage life, therefore, it is very significant for the teachers to be have a firm grasp of the subject;
