SERVICE BOARD

The Career Executive Service Board (CESB), in accordance with its mandate of promoting the career development of members of the Career Executive Service (CES), has developed and administered various training programs and other human resource development interventions available to Career Executive Service Officers (CESOs) and CES eligibles with the end in mind of forming a continuing pool of well-selected and development-oriented career administrators who shall provide competent and faithful service.

Pursuant to CESB Resolution No. 615 dated February 14, 2006, the CESB finds it appropriate to allow Career Service Executive eligibles (CSEEs) to participate in the various training programs and other human resource development interventions primarily available exclusively to Career Executive Service Officers (CESOs) and CES eligibles.

Allowing CSEEs to participate in the CESB's training programs and other human resource development interventions will enable them to build and develop specific management and leadership competencies needed in the effective performance of their functions.

Henceforth, all CSEEs who are occupying at least a Division Chief position or its equivalent, may now participate in the training and human resource development programs offered by the CESB.
