



EXPANSION OF THE MODIFIED IN-SCHOOL OFF-SCHOOL APPROACH: (MISOSA)
AN ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY MODE IN PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary Schools

1. The Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) through the Curriculum Development Division (CDD) in cooperation with United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) is undertaking an alternative delivery mode of basic education to address problems of classes in some elementary schools with big enrolment. This is called Modified In-School Off-School Approach (MISOSA) utilizing self-instructions materials.
2. The Project was piloted in School Year 2005-2006 in six (6) divisions composed of 14 public elementary schools (Enclosure No.1). For School Year 2006-2007, said project will be expanded to 68 more public elementary schools under the Country Program for Children Year 6 (CPC6) areas with funding support from UNICEF.
3. All regions/divisions concerned are requested to identify and submit the names of the schools (Enclosure No. 2) with big class size together with the identified regional coordinator on or before June 5, 2006. An orientation for coordinators will be conducted by the BEE.
