- 3.3 The tournament shall run on single elimination or knock out system.
- 4.4 A player may be entered in not more than (2) events.
- 5.5 A ten (10) minutes grace period on the scheduled match will be given, otherwise, the player will be declared loser by walk over.
- 6.6 Only the Team Manager, Coach are allowed to approach the table official with regards with the protest and inquiries.

## III. ELIGIBILITY

3.1 The following player may join:

- 3.2 Former, current national team, training pool and those who participated in the international competition are not allowed.
- 3.3 Age categories are strictly enforced, any player caught altering his / her age shall be penalized by banning them to participate in all PBA and DepEd sanctioned tournament including the coach for allowing such action.
- 3.4 Player must submit a duly authenticated birth certificate by the local Civil Registrar.
- 3.5 Player also must submit certification that they are currently enrolled and bonafide students / pupil for the School Year 2006-2007 signed by the Principal / School Registrar.

## IV. SEEDING

- 4.1 Seeding of player shall be based on the following:
  - Highest achievement in the Palarong Pambansa
  - Batang Pinoy
  - Tournament sanctioned by the PBA

### V. UNFORSEEN EVENT

- 5.1 The decision of Referee on any question or disputes during the competition is
- 5.2 In case of the unforeseen event or circumstances not within the control of the player, the Tournament Director may suspend the play as he considered necessary. If the play may be suspended, the existing score shall stand and play be resumed from that point it was disrupted.

# VI. SCORING SYSTEM

6.1 The IBF Standard scoring system Raily 21 points, best of two games will be implemented in this tournament.

### VII. PLAYING ATTIRE

7.1 All players are required to use their playing uniform or must be prescribed Badminton Uniform.

## VIII. PROTEST

- 8.1 All appeals / protest must be submitted in writing by the Coach thirty (30) numutes after the match to the technical committee / tournament Manager.
- 8.2 Such appeals / protest must be accompanied by a fee P 5,000.00 which is NON REFUNDABLE whatever the decision made by the technical committee/ Tournament Manager.

9.1 A registration of (100.00) per athlete / player will be collected by the Organizing Committee. Only the duly registered player(s) will be allowed to play
