  - c) conduct and monitoring of the synchronized Student Government elections and the requisite turn-over of responsibilities, and school-based training of newly-elected Student Government officers; and
  - d) compliance with the mandated projects and activities of the Student Government as indicated in Section 8, Article X of the Constitution and By-Laws pursuant to DepED Order No. 43, s. 2005 and in Paragraph 4 of DepED Memorandum No. 35, s. 2006.
- 3. The SGP aims to make available to students real exposure, experience and learning in responsible and participative democracy and leadership; and harness the Student Government as a partner in achieving quality education and academic excellence in schools.
- 4. All Regional Directors, Schools Division/City Superintendents, School Principals/Heads and Teachers of Araling Panlipunan are tasked to support the activities and intensify the implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the Student Government Program.
- 5. At the national level, the Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA) is in-charge of monitoring and coordinating the activities of the SGP.
