**THRUSTS AND ACTIVITIES FOR THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT PROGRAM (SGP)  
FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2006-2007**

1. The Department of Education (DepED) announces the Thrusts and the Synchronized Schedule of Activities for the Student Government Program (SGP) for School Year 2006-2007. These activities center on the theme "Building Leaders, Strengthening Communities and Making Them Work."

2. The SGP's thrusts this School Year focus on the following:



- a) establishment of Student Government Federations in the division, regional and national levels as ready mechanisms for student consultations and as sources of policy recommendations on issues and concerns that affect them;
- b) full adoption and implementation of the Standard Constitution and By-Laws pursuant to DepED Order No. 43, s. 2005 by all public secondary schools;
- c) conduct and monitoring of the synchronized Student Government elections and the requisite turn-over of responsibilities, and school-based training of newly-elected Student Government officers; and
- d) compliance with the mandated projects and activities of the Student Government as indicated in Section 8, Article X of the Constitution and By-Laws pursuant to DepED Order No. 43, s. 2005 and in Paragraph 4 of DepED Memorandum No. 35, s. 2006.

3. The SGP aims to make available to students real exposure, experience and learning in responsible and participative democracy and leadership; and harness the Student Government as a partner in achieving quality education and academic excellence in schools.

4. All Regional Directors, Schools Division/City Superintendents, School Principals/Heads and Teachers of Araling Panlipunan are tasked to support the activities and intensify the implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the Student Government Program.

5. At the national level, the Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA) is in-charge of monitoring and coordinating the activities of the SGP.
