IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CY 2006 PRINCIPAL-LED
SCHOOLBUILDING PROGRAM BATCH 2

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The 1st Batch of the CY 2006 Principal-Led Schoolbuilding Program is now on the procurement stage and the Physical Facilities and Schools Engineering Division (PFSED) is now to implement the 2nd batch covered by SARO 001153 dated March 17, 2006 in the amount of Four Hundred Ninety Four Million Eight Hundred Eleven Thousand Three Hundred Pesos (PhP494,811,300.00).

2. In view of this, the second wave of the Orientation Seminar-Workshop for the implementers of the Principal-Led Schoolbuilding Program will be undertaken nationwide. The orientation seminar-workshop aims to orient the stakeholders on the implementation scheme of the CY 2006 Principal-Led Schoolbuilding Program through lectures/discussions on the following:



- a. Orientation on the Principal-Led Implementation Scheme;
- b. Consultation and finalization of the proposed program of works;
- c. Procurement procedures, schedules and contract monitoring;
- d. Strategic and Detailed Implementation Planning; and
- e. Acceptance and Maintenance of completed projects.

3. The PFSED will still be using the Principal-Led Schoolbuilding Program scheme which is one of the innovations introduced by the Department to ensure the strengthening school-based management and encourage the participation of the community and technical assistance from professional engineers through the decentralized construction of schoolbuildings. Target participants to the orientation seminar-workshops are the Regional Directors, Schools Division/City Superintendents, School Heads of recipient schools, Regional/Division Physical Facilities Coordinators, Regional/Division Accountants who have not attended any related orientation, DepED Project Engineers, and PFSED Central Office staff. Enclosed for references are the Schedule of Activities as Enclosure No. 1 and the Confirmation Slip as Enclosure No. 2.

4. To save government resources the 5-day Orientation Seminar-Workshop will devote two (2) days for the Training of DepED Volunteers for Project A.S.S.I.S.T. (Assessment of Schoolbuildings' Structural Integrity and Stability), most of the participants of which are also participants of the PL-SBP orientation. The Project will be undertaken in seven (7) phases in cooperation with the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) through the Local Government Units (LGUs), Department of National Defense (DND) through the AFP-Engineering Brigade, Association of Structural Engineers of the Philippines (ASEP), and the Philippine Institute of Civil Engineers (PICE).

5. Expenses for board and lodging, honorarium of speakers and facilitators, supplies and learning kits of the participants and traveling expenses of Central Office participants will be charged against the Engineering and Administrative Cost of the Schoolbuilding Program of the Department. Traveling expenses of regional/division participants will be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
