## ENSURING FULL ISSUANCE OF SUMMER 2006 RICE ALLOCATION TO ALL FSP BENEFICIARIES

To: Regional Directors
City/Schools Division Superintendents
Heads of Elementary Schools covered by the
Food for School Program

- 1. This is a follow-up to DepED Memorandum No. 129 s. 2006 relative to the President's instruction to extend rice distribution to all beneficiaries of the Food for School Program (FSP) during summer covering April 24 June 2, 2006.
- 2. Due to the delayed dissemination of the Memorandum and also the delay in the delivery of rice in some areas, there is a possibility that some beneficiaries might have missed their intended volume of rice allocation for summer.
- 3. All heads of FSP implementing schools should see to it that all beneficiaries have received their intended ration of 40 kg. of rice during summer. Had there been deficiency in the volume of rice deliveries, it should be reported to and coordinated immediately with the NFA local offices/warehouses. Recipient pupils who spent their summer vacation somewhere should likewise be provided with the 40 kilos of rice until July 14, 2006. If the rice allocation remains unclaimed after July 14, the rice will be used for the feeding of identified undernourished pupils in Grades II-VI. Teaching and non-teaching staff shall strictly be excluded from the rice ration.
- 4. All concerned officials are requested to submit reports on the Food for School Program to the Office of the Secretary, DepED Central Office, Pasig City. Such consolidated report should include the nutritional status (before and after implementation) of the beneficiaries, rice distribution and attendance, among others. Implementation issues and problems may also be included in the report.

Immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
