

READING ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES (RAP) MIDYEAR DEMOFEST

- 1. The Reading Association of the Philippines (RAP), the national affiliate of the International Reading Association, in cooperation with the Department of Education (DepED), will hold its Midyear Demofest on the theme "The Art of Reading in the Disciplines" at Hotel Venezia, Legaspi City on October 20-22, 2006.
- 2. The demofest aims to:
 - a. increase the awareness of the participants on the importance of reading as a tool in teaching the content subjects;
 - b. update the Reading teachers and educators on effective strategies in integrating the teaching of reading in the content areas.
- 3. Participants to this demofest are school administrators, chairpersons/department heads, reading program coordinators and classroom teachers at all levels.
- 4. Arrangements for substitute teachers must be made to ensure that the classes of the participating teachers will not be disrupted.
- 5. A registration fee of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP2,500.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for lunches, snacks, materials, certificate and other incidental expenses. Discounted rate on registration fee will be given for RAP members and early bird registrants. Participants will make their own arrangements for accommodation. The program of activities, registration rates and list of hotels are enclosed. Since the venue's seating capacity is 500, the participants are encouraged to register early.
- 6. Travel expenses incident to the attendance in the convention shall be charged against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants coming from private schools shall make their own financial arrangements with their respective schools and/or sponsoring organizations.
