## CLEAN-UP AND GREEN THE WORLD MONTH

- 1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 224, s. 1993, the Department of Education (DepED) in coordination with the United Nations Environment Program (UNEP), celebrates the Clean-up and Green the World Month this September. The program is spearheaded by Clean-up the World Foundation headed by Ian Kiernon of Australia. The DepED and other government agencies shall observe the following activities:
  - a. Kick-off of the Clean-up and Green the World Month on September 24, 2006 at NBN Channel 4 program "Sining Gising", Sunday, 4:00-6:00 p.m., 140 other countries will also kick-off on this day.
  - b. Ozone Day September 16, 2006
  - c. Coastal Clean-up of the International Maritime Alliance September 17, 2006
  - d. Urban Pest Control September 24-30, 2006
- 2. The celebration aims to utilize the arts as a medium to promote values education particularly on environmental awareness.
- 3. As a fitting observance of the said celebration, the DepED Central Office, Regional and Division offices and all schools are encouraged to undertake any of the following suggested activities/projects that will strengthen the Clean-up and Green the World Month:
  - a. Display of Streamer with the theme "Ang Malinis na Kapaligiran ang Ating Pamana";
  - b. Seminar or activities using the arts as medium to promote values on environmental awareness:
  - c. Revival of Gawad Linis Lunti sa Paaralan (nationwide);
  - d. Balagtasan on Climate Change; and Rap Hip Hop Contest;
  - e. On the Spot Painting of Posters at the Ninoy Aquino Park September 22-23, 2006;
  - f. Literary Contest November 12, 2006;
  - g. Cartoon Editorial Contest in Newspaper of Material Circulation (to be announced later);
  - h. Singing Contest on the Environment (Solo and Chorale) on "Sining Gising" NBN Channel 4 September 24, 2006 (DENR-NCR);
  - i. Interview with NGO's, PO's and Government Agencies about Cleanup activities on morning shows on Television (GMA, ABS-CBN/Cable and Government Media);
  - j. Gallery of the Sea at the SM Mall of Asia or at the Manila Yacht Club.

- 4. Expenses for transportation, per diem, and allowance of DepED Central Office Committee and other incidental expenses during the Regional/Cluster and National Competitions will be charged to OSEC funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
