TRAINING OF TRAINERS ON CHILD-FRIENDLY AND CREATIVE TEACHING APPROACHES IN ENGLISH, SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
All Others Concerned

- 1. The Department of Education (DepED), the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), with the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) and the Peace Corps will conduct a Training of Trainers on Child-Friendly and Creative Teaching Approaches in English, Science and Mathematics on October 13-17, 2006 at Bohol Tropics, Graham Avenue, Tagbilaran City, Bohol. This training is intended to support the Child-Friendly School System (CFSS) Program of DepED-UNICEF
- 2. The objectives of the training workshop are to:

a. demonstrate creative teaching strategies in English, Science and Mathematics that is child-centered and interactive;

b. orient subject area supervisors/coordinators in the use of the mentoring handbook and other manuals as guide to their mentoring teachers using approaches that are teacher-friendly, so the teachers in turn will be child-friendly in their teaching;

c. orient and deepen their appreciation of the effectivity of a Child-Friendly School System (CFSS) to improve students' attitudes, knowledge and skills.

- 3. The participants to this training are subject area supervisors/coordinators of English, Science and Mathematics on both elementary and high school levels. Each of the 24 CFSS divisions can send 3 subject area division supervisors or coordinators, who are 58 years and below and who are not due for promotion within a year's time and 1 CFSS division or district coordinator, a total of 4 participants per CFSS division (Enclosure No. 1).
- 4. Expenses related to the workshop which include accommodation, meals, per diem, workshop materials, kits, handbooks and manuals of the participants, resource persons and staff, including travel expenses, honoraria of resource persons and staff and other incidental expenses are funded by UNICEF (See Enclosure No., 3 for the List of Resource Persons and Staff). To facilitate travel arrangements, participants are requested to fax or email their travel itinerary and details to Ms. Lyka Kasala: ekalsa@unicef.org or fax UNICEF (02) 729-4524; tel. nos. - 5. Participants are expected to check in after lunch, Day 0, October 12, with registration at 3:00 p.m. and Program Engagement Activities at 5:00 p.m. and dinner after. The Opening Program is on October 13 a.m. while the Closing Program is on October 17 p.m. Check out is after breakfast of October 18 Enclosure No. 2.
