





GAD FOCAL POINTS ASSEMBLY AND STRATEGIC PLANNING WORKSHOP

To: Undersecretaries
Assistant Secretaries
Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Directors of Services/Centers and Heads of Units
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. For the proper implementation of Gender and Development (GAD) Programs, Focal Points were mandated to be designated by each government agency up to the sub-regional levels (IRR for RA 7192 Sec. 4 (d) and Sec. 9) to coordinate gender related activities in their workplace and to ensure sustained efforts on GAD.
2. In preparation for the submission of the Department's progress/accomplishments report on GAD, a 5-day conference-workshop shall be held on November 20-24, 2006 at ECOTECH Center, Cebu City, by the Staff Development Division-Human Resource Development Service (SDD-HRDS).
3. Participants are GAD Focal Points or GAD Coordinators at the regional and division levels, for a maximum of six (6) participants per region. They are advised to bring a copy of their accomplishment report on GAD (the Regional GAD Focal Point shall bring a copy of the reports of school divisions not represented), covering the topics listed in the enclosure.

5. Travel expenses and per diem (before and after the training) of participants are chargeable against local funds, while board and lodging of participants and staff and travel expenses, per diem (before and after the training), extra duty allowance of the facilitators and staff and other incidental expenses of the training are chargeable against Special Program Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is requested.
