2006 NATIONAL EDUCATORS CONGRESS

- 1. The 2006 National Educators Congress for both public and private schools shall be held at the Teachers Camp, Baguio City on December 5 7, 2006. The theme of the Congress is "Promoting the Culture of Performance and Accountability Through School-Based Management".
- 2. The National Educators Congress aims to:
 - a. determine the extent, strengths and areas of development of SBM implementation in the education system;
 - b. identify lessons learned from SBM experiences; and
 - c. define directions in the SBM implementation and formulate strategies of collaboration.
- 3. The participants are Regional Directors and Assistant Regional Directors, Schools Division Superintendent or Assistant Schools Division Superintendent (1 per division), Division Supervisors (1 per division), Elementary School Principals (2 per division), High School Principals (1 per division), Elementary Master Teachers (1 per region), Secondary Master Teachers (1 per region), Private School Principals / Directors (1 per region), Elementary Education Chiefs or Assistant Chiefs, Secondary Education Chiefs or Assistant Chiefs, Alternative Learning System (ALS) Coordinators (1 per region), Heads of the Regional Health and Nutrition Units (1 per region), LGU Representatives (2 per region), PTCA Representatives (1 per region) and Youth Leaders (1 per region).
- 4. Authorized to attend from the DepED Central Office are Undersecretaries, Assistant Secretaries, Bureau Directors and Assistant Directors, Service and Center Directors, Heads of Units, Chiefs of Divisions and designated Congress Committee Chairs and Members.
- 5. A registration fee of Five Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php5,500.00) shall be paid by each participant to be charged to local funds or other available funds. This amount shall be used to cover expenses for the conference materials, breakfast (4), snacks (6), lunch (3) and dinner (4). Meals shall be served starting with dinner on December 4 and ending with breakfast on December 8, 2006. This is a live-in Congress and the registration fee also covers the accommodation.

- 6. The Regional Directors are requested to submit the list of participants for preregistration. Pre-registration and payment in cash are encouraged. Check payments
 should be made payable to the "Educators Congress" as early as November 8, 2006.
 Personal checks of registrants from Metro Manila and provincial checks for areas
 with Central Bank clearing offices will be accepted. The registration fee with the
 corresponding accomplished registration form and a certification or letter from the
 Regional Director authorizing the delegate's attendance to the Congress should be
 submitted to Mrs. Olivia M. San Pablo, Chief Accountant, Accounting Division,
 Department of Education, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City. Pre-registration will ensure
 the participant of a complete set of conference materials. For more information,
