8<sup>TH</sup> NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION OF PSYCHO-SOCIAL HELPING PROFESSIONALS (PAPSHP)

- 1. The Philippine Association of Psycho-Social Helping Professionals (PAPSHP) will hold the 8th National Convention on November 7-8, 2006 at the Manila Pavillon, United Nations Avenue, Manila with the theme "Intergenerational Solidarity: An Approach to Social Transformation".
- 2. The convention aims to:
  - a. establish resources available to helping professionals so they can foster intergenerational solidarity to promote social transformation in their contexts;
  - b. situate intergenerational solidarity in their personal and professional transformations; and
  - c. organize helping professionals so they can engage in collaborative undertaking either to conduct research or design research-based program to foster intergenerational solidarity.
- 3. Participants to this convention are members of PAPSHP, classroom teachers, guidance counselors, school psychologists, social workers, and others who are involved in teaching/learning and guidance counseling in the elementary, secondary and tertiary levels from public/state or private institutions.
- 4. The registration fee is Two Thousand and Five Hundred Pesos (PhP2,500.00). Existing members can avail of 10% discount, upon presentation of proof of membership. Participants from state/public institutions may attend on official time. Likewise, those from private sectors may make arrangement with their school administrators.
