6TH NATIONAL TEACHERS CONGRESS ON VISUAL IMPAIRMENT

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

- 1. The Department of Education (DepED), through the Special Education Division (SPED) of the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE), in cooperation with the Resources for the Blind, Inc. (RBI) and Christoffel Blindenmission will hold the 6th National Teachers Congress on Visual Impairment at the Subic International Hotel, Subic Bay Freeport Zone, Olongapo City on December 13-15, 2006. The theme of the Congress is "New Challenges and Strategies to Achieve Equality in Education of Children with Visual Impairment".
- 2. The Congress aims to:
 - a. improve the skills of specialized and general classroom teachers to facilitate access for all children with visual impairment in appropriate programs;
 - b. identify means to effectively facilitate the necessary educational provision to all children with visual impairment; and
 - c. identify strategies to overcome the different challenges of providing effective educational program to children with visual impairment.
- 3. Special education teachers, school administrators with special education programs from public and private schools, supervisors in-charge of special education from the regional and sub-regional levels, superintendents, assistant superintendents, chiefs/assistant chiefs of the Elementary and Secondary Divisions, other GOs and NGOs working for children with special needs are invited to attend on official business.
- 4. Transportation, registration fees, per diem and other allowable expenses incident to the participation of those coming from the government institutions shall be charged against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting rules and regulations. Participants from private institutions shall make their own financial arrangements with their respective schools/offices.
- 5. The program of activities and registration fees are found in Enclosures Nos. 1, 2a and b.
- 6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
