NATIONAL SUMMIT ON THEATER ARTS EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors

Heads, Public and Private Elementary Schools

- 1. The Philippine Association of Theater Arts Professionals (PASTAP) in coordination with the Commission of Higher Education (CHED), Department of Education (DepED), Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP), Albay Provincial Government through the Provincial Council for Culture and the Arts (PCCA) and the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) will conduct a National Summit on Theater Arts Education on December 27-30, 2006 at the Hotel La Trinidad, Bicol University, Legaspi City.
- 2. The theme of the summit is "Theater Arts Education, A Vehicle to Achieve the UN Millennium Goals for Social Transformation (Education, Human Development and Poverty Alleviation)". Enclosed is the program of activities.
- 3. The objectives of the summit are to:
 - a. enhance awareness on the UN Millennium Development goals focused on education human development and poverty alleviation;
 - b. develop strategies in the use of theater arts education as a tool for achieving the goals for education, human development and poverty alleviation;
 - c. train teachers, mentors and facilitators on learning the Creative Theater methodology;
 - d. share with theater arts professionals to develop knowledge, attitudes and values which lead to progressive thinking and doing in education; and
 - e. to provide an avenue for theater arts education practitioners to hone their artistic skills and demonstrate their artistic crafts.
- 4. The participants to the summit are Department Heads on Speech, Theater Arts Education Professionals, professors and teachers at all levels from both private and public schools, curriculum designers developing the new generation theater arts

arts education and all those who wish to promote theater arts education as a vehicle for social transformation. Attendance of public school participants shall be on official business.

- 5. A registration fee of Three Thousand Pesos (PhP3,000.00) shall be charged to each participant. Expenses shall be charged to MOOE, local funds (such as but not limited to PTCA, local school board, regional and division funds) or maybe sourced from the municipal/provincial funds or associations subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
