DepED MEMORANDUM No. 425, s. 2006

OBSERVANCE OF THE 110TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE MARTYRDOM OF DR. JOSE P. RIZAL

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools
All Others Concerned

- 1. Pursuant to Proclamation No. 126, entitled "Declaring the Month of December of every year as Rizal Month", the Department of Education (DepED) as chairman of the National Organizing Committee (NOC), and the National Historical Institute (NHI) as chairman of the National Technical Working Committee (NTWC) were tasked to organize and undertake programs to be participated in by all national government agencies, local government units, government owned and controlled corporations, and non-government organizations and associations for the observance of the 110th Anniversary of the Martyrdom of Dr. Jose P. Rizal.
- 2. The Secretary, as chairman of the occasion, enjoins all DepED regional, division, district, and field offices to actively participate in the nationwide colebration. Likewise, the following DepED Regional/Division offices are requested to coordinate with their respective local government units (LGU's) regarding their participation in the simultaneous Flag-Raising Ceremony and the Rizal Annual Lectures on December 30, 2006 respectively:
 - a. National Capital Region all fourteen (14) Divisions (Regional Director, Division Superintendents, and other Officials)
 - b. Cordillera Administrative Region Division of Baguio City (Regional Director, Division Superintendents, and other Officials and teachers)
 - c. Region IV-Calabarzon Division of Calamba City (Regional Director, Division Superintendents, and other Officials and teachers)
 - d. Region IX Zamboanga Del Norte Division of Dapitan City (Regional Director, Division Superintendents, and other Officials and teachers)
- 3. This Department through the Special Events Unit, the National Historical Institute, and other member agencies has agreed carry out the 2006 Search for the Rizal sa Makabagong Panahon in the seventeen (17) regions as an integral part of the Rizal National Festival of Excellence (RNFE) conducted nationwide.
- 4. Enclosed are the Schedule of Activities, Search for the Rizal sa Makabagong Panahon Guidelines, and the Search Entry Form.

- 5. The travel expenses (transportation and per diem) of the nominees, Division Special Events Coordinators shall be charged against local funds such as but not limited to PTCA, local school board funds, MOOE, Regional/Division funds) or maybe sourced from the municipal/city and provincial funds, NGO's, civic spirited clubs, associations, and organizations subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. Expenses for the Board and Lodging of the awardees, Division Special Events Coordinators, medals, plaques, frames, honoraria of the Board of Judges, emcees (Rizal Quiz, Music Theater Competition, Oratorical Contest, and Search for the Rizal sa Makabagong Panahon) shall be charged against the Presidents Contingent Fund for Rizal Day FY 2006. While the Cash Prizes for the 17 Regional winners, 5 Cluster Finalist, and the National Winner, supplies and materials, documentation and communication, token for the RNFE participants, travel expenses and extraduty allowance of the DepED Technical Working Committee, and other incidental expenses shall be charged to OSEC funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

SEARCH FOR THE "RIZAL SA MAKABAGONG PANAHON 2006"

- 1. The search for the RIZAL SA MAKABAGONG PANAHON 2006 aims to:
 - Recognize the outstanding students in their achievements and contributions in their school and community,
 - Deepen one's pride in being a Filipino;
 - Raise the level of historical/cultural awareness and consciousness of the students relative to the significance of the 110th Anniversary of the Martyrdom of Dr. Jose P. Rizal;
 - Relearn the value of the historical struggle of our national hero to emulate by the youth as future leaders of this country;
 - Inspire the youth with the compelling contemporary relevance of Rizal, his life, humanity, and love of country; and
 - Affirm and invigorate the spirit and capacity of the youth to excel and become 'The Best in the Land" like Rizal.
- 2. The qualifications of the nominees for the RIZAL SA MAKABAGONG PANAHON are as follows:
 - a. a natural-born Filipino citizen
 - a fourth year secondary school (public/private) student, batch 2006-2007 duly recognized by the Department of Education (DepED);
 - c. with leadership and academic achievements/qualities;
 - d. an officer/member of a school and /or community organizations.
- 3. The criteria for the selection are as follows:
 - a. Performance.
 - i. **Community Service (30%).** This refers to leadership and involvement in projects where the beneficiary is the school/municipality/ division/ region etc.
 - ii. **Scholastic Achievement (30%).** This refers to any group/organization or activity/project led or participated in by the nominee whether connected with the school or not, as long as it has some relation to academic performance.
 - iii. **Versatility (20%).** The nominee must be versatile both in his academic and leadership performance.
 - b. **Personality and Character (20%)** Behavioral indicators that reflect the good citizenship values of a person (Maka-Diyos, Maka-Tao, at Maka-Bansa)
- 4. The regional search shall be managed by the Regional Special Events Coordinator under the auspices of the regional office headed by the Regional Director with the members from the Selection/Screening Committee chaired by the Regional Special Events Coordinator. The Regional Director may appoint other members of the committee.
- 5. Each region is entitled to one (1) Regional nominee. The deadline for submission will be on or before December 15, 2006. Each nominee will have to submit a Biodata stating all his/her academic and leadership qualifications to be certified by the principal, Schools Division /City Superintendent and finally by the Regional Director (please attach latest colored picture (2x2), certifications, and other pertinent papers duly certified by the authorities, etc.).

- 8. The seventeen (17) Regional awardees will receive a RIZAL Medal and a cash prize from the National Organizing Committee (NOC).
- 9. The five (5) cluster awardees will receive a PLAQUE OF RECOGNITION and a cash prize from NOC.
- 10. There will be a one (1) national winner which will receive a PLAQUE OF RECOGNITION and a cash prize from NOC.
