
DepEd MEMORANDUM

52nd NDAP CONVENTION

To: Bureau/Center/Service Directors

1. The Nutritionist-Dietitians' Association of the Philippines (NDAP), the professional nutrition organization accredited by the Professional Regulations Commission (PRC) will hold its 52nd Annual Convention on February 19-20, 2007 at the Waterfront Hotel (formerly Manila Pavilion Hotel), UN Avenue, Ermita, Manila.
2. Activities during the Convention shall revolve around the theme, "Strengthening Partnership for Effective Nutrition-Dietetics Practice." The convention shall serve as a venue to discuss the critical and challenging role of nutritionist-dietitians in various field i.e. medical nutrition, public health, academe and food service. It shall serve also as an occasion for dialogue and sharing success stories, issues and concerns between and among nutritionist-dietitians from other agencies, organizations with that of their partners and clients, purportedly to ensure effective and efficient delivery of nutrition and health services.
3. This is a live-out gathering and a convention fee of P2,500.00 for early registration or P2,950.00 for in-site registration shall be charged to each participant to cover morning and afternoon snacks and lunch for two days.
4. Cognizant of the benefits that can derive in this Convention in terms of professional growth and updating of knowledge and improvement in work performance, attendance of the 32 DepEd-based nutritionist-dietitians shall be on official business. Cost of travel and the convention fee shall be charged from local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
