SECOND NATIONAL CONGRESS OF PUBLIC SECONDARY SCHOOL HEADS

1. The National Public Secondary School Heads, Inc. (NAPSSHI) in coordination with the Department of Education, through the Bureau of Secondary Education, shall hold its **Second National Congress of Public Secondary School Heads** on February 19-21, 2007 at Villa Caceres Hotel, Naga City. This year's theme is "Principalship: Soaring High as Catalyst for Change".

2. The Congress aims to:

- a. further equip school principals with the direction and thrust of the government units directly affecting school management and enable them to pursue effective school governance;
- b. enable administrators to exchange notes of experience on the schools first initiative, adopt-a-school program, technology and livelihood education/industrial arts education and other interventions to involve the community in introducing and instituting education reforms; and
- c. give a fresh look at accreditation as a tool for bridging education reform efforts in secondary education and for guaranteeing systemic quality reforms in the key elements of secondary education.

3. Participants to this Congress are principals/assistant principals/head teachers/master teachers/TICs/OICs of annex schools of public national, general and comprehensive secondary schools, chiefs or assistant chiefs of Secondary Education Divisions, division and regional supervisors and assistant superintendents in-charge of secondary education. Designated committee members are authorized to travel two days before the conference. Attendance to this conference is **on official business**.

4. A Congress fee of Four Thousand Nine Hundred Pesos (PhP4,900.00) shall be charged each participant to cover expenses for board and lodging, congress materials and kits, honoraria of speakers and other incidental expenses. First meal shall be dinner of February 18.
