FIRST SUMMER SEMINAR-WORKSHOP FOR HISTORY TEACHERS

- 1. The De La Salle University, History Department will hold its First Summer Seminar-Workshop for History Teachers on April 16-17, 2007 at the De La Salle University, Manila.
- 2. The theme of the seminar-workshop is "Teaching History Using the Transformative Learning Framework: Concepts, Approaches and Issues". Cognizant of the need to prepare the students for a life-long learning, it aims to help promote the use of the Transformative Learning Pedagogy (TLP) as a potentially effective approach to teaching history.
- 3. The objectives of the seminar -workshop are to:
 - a. clarify the concepts, the rationale and the procedures involved in the implementation of the Transformative Learning Pedagogy;
 - b. identify and address some issues in the implementation of the Transformative Learning Approach in the teaching of history; and
 - c. encourage history teachers to adopt or formulate new ideas and methods suitable to the changing conditions being fostered by globalization.
- 4. The participants are history/civic teachers in elementary and secondary schools, writers, editors and publishers of history textbooks, curriculum writers and implementors; and graduate students of history and related disciplines.
- 5. A registration fee of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP 1,500.00) will be charged each participant to cover snacks and lunch for two (2) days, conference kit, photocopies of lecture papers/outlines and Certificates of Attendance and Appearance.
