## SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON HISTORIOGRAPHY AND THE SOCIAL SCIENCES

- 1. The Bagong Kasaysayan-Bahay Saliksikan sa Kasaysayan (BAKAS), Inc. in partnership with the Department of Social Sciences, College of Arts and Sciences and the Graduate School of Philosophy of San Beda College, Manila will hold the 5<sup>th</sup> BAKAS National Seminar-Workshop in Historiography and the Social Sciences on April 18-20, 2007 at the Multimedia Room, San Beda College, Manila.
- 2. The theme of the seminar-workshop is "Kamalayang Panrelihiyon at Pambansa: Pagbabalik-Aral sa Karanasang Ispiritwal ng mga Pilipino sa Agos ng Kasaysayan at ang Nagpapatuloy na Papel ng Relihiyon sa Lipunan at Estadong Pilipino".
- 3. The objectives of the seminar-workshop are to:
  - a. appraise the teachers of the present state of the Philippine social sciences, particularly historiography and its directions in the 21st century;
  - b. provide the teachers with a wholistic understanding of the social sciences i.e, an understanding crucial to a meaningful approach to the integration of the social sciences in the various subject areas and vice versa; and
  - c. inform about, and help the teachers appreciate recent curricular developments; as well as techniques and methods of teaching, research and publications, including the use of modern information technology in the classroom.
- 4. The participants to this activity are teachers from both elementary and secondary schools. Attendance of public school teachers is on **official time only**.
- 5. A registration fee of Two Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (PhP2,800.00) shall be charged each participant inclusive of the seminar kit (program abstract of papers, papers) snacks and lunch for three (2) days and certificate of participation. An optional tour of the religious/spiritual sites in Manila will be conducted outside of the 3-day seminar-workshop. It shall be held on April 21, 2007 and is limited only (on a first come, first served basis) to participants from provinces outside of NCR.
