SUMMER ACTIVITIES OF SCHOOL HEALTH AND NUTRITION PERSONNEL

To: Bureau Directors

Regional Directors

Schools Division/City Superintendents

Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. All school health and nutrition personnel shall perform the following activities during the months of April and May:
  - a. conduct health examination of prospective Grade I entrants, teachers and non-teaching personnel;
  - b. monitor the compliance/progress to treatment of teachers/non-teaching personnel found to be afflicted with PTB;
  - c. organize medical and dental missions and emergency feeding specifically in areas affected by typhoons *Reming* and *Milenyo*;
  - d. conduct school feeding program to Grade I entrants/children at-risk, in coordination with government agencies, LGUs and other civic-spirited organizations;
  - e. get involved in the School Maintenance Week on May 21-25, 2007, giving particular attention to the improvement of the school clinic and other health facilities;
  - f. plan for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Universal Medical and Dental Check-up and other activities and targets for SY 2007-2008;
  - g. conduct information dissemination on disaster preparedness/response; and
  - h. prepare project proposals to generate additional funds for the various health and nutrition programs/projects.
- 2. The schedule of visits to the schools shall be prepared by the concerned personnel, in close coordination with the district supervisors and school heads, and duly approved by the schools division superintendent.
- 3. The Regional Health and Nutrition Unit staff are expected to monitor the activities and consolidate the health data to be included in their  $2^{nd}$  quarter report.
- 4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
