WORLD LINKS-PHILIPPINES TEACHER PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

- 1. The Foundation for IT Education and Development (FIT-ED), in coordination with this Department shall implement the World Links-Philippines Teacher Professional Development Program on Telecollaborative Learning and Web-Enhanced Learning Activities under the ASEAN SchoolNet Program of the Japan Social Development Fund.
- 2. The training program on telecollaborative learning aims to introduce participants to educational telecollaboration its creation, design, implementation and dissemination. On the other hand, the training program on web-enhanced learning activities intends to provide teachers with skills in designing web-enhanced learning activities.
- 3. Participants to the training programs are selected secondary school teachers of English, Science, Araling Panlipunan and Filipino who have undergone trainings on basic applications and ICT integration/instruction.
- 4. The Regional Offices, in coordination with the Division Offices are requested to nominate a minimum of five (5) and a maximum of eight (8) teachers for consideration into the program. Selection of Regional Trainers

Qualifications

- 1. Must come from a secondary school in a division belonging to the region, which:
 - a. A computer laboratory with at least 10 working and networked computers
 - b. Has reliable and stable internet access in the computer laboratory/ies
 - c. Has assigned technical support for their computer facilities
- 2. Must be a subject area teacher teaching any of the following subject areas:
 - a. English 1 to 4
 - b. Science 1 to 2
 - c. Araling Panlipunan 1 to 4
 - d. Filipino 1 to 4

Note: Strictly no Math or TLE teachers

- 3. Must be computer literate:
 - a. Proficient in using productivity tools (word processing, spreadsheet, and presentation software)
 - b. Proficient in using e-mail and the internet
- 4. Must have experience in classroom implementation of ICT-enhanced lessons and learning activities
- 5. Must be willing to attend the training in April 2007.

Requirements

- 1. Letter of Endorsement from the Division Superintendent
- 2. Letter of Intent signed by the School Administrator where the nominee comes from
- 3. Accomplished School Profile Form
- 4. Letter of Intent signed by the nominee
- 5. Accomplished Competency Assessment Form
