CERTIFICATE PROGRAM FOR HIGH SCHOOL NON-SPECIALIST TEACHERS IN SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS FOR SUMMER

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents

- 1. This Department, through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) and the Regional Offices, in partnership with the Regional Science Teaching Centers (RSTCs) and Centers for Excellence (COEs), announces the Summer Certificate Program for Non-Specialist High School Teachers in Science and Mathematics (Batches 1 and 2, Term 2), which shall be conducted this Summer 2007.
- 2. The Certificate Program seeks to improve the capacity of teachers who are non-specialists in science and mathematics by equipping them with knowledge of content, strategies in teaching and tools for assessing learning.
- 3. The Certificate Program is a 24-unit program leading to a minor in the sciences or mathematics. The Term 2 Summer Program shall be a six-week intensive course. First day of classes may begin on April 11, 2007 (on special arrangement with the RSTCs/COEs).
- 4. Participants in the Term 2 Summer Program shall be those who have undergone the Term 1 of the program at the Regional Science Teaching Centers (RSTCs), Centers of Excellence and/or Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) in the regions in Summer 2006 (Batch 1) and the Saturday classes during SY 2006-2007 (Batch 2). The RSTCs/COEs are listed by region in the enclosed Summary Table of Participating Institutions.
- 5. Each participant shall receive Twelve Thousand Pesos (PhP12,000.00) for stipend and Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP2,500.00) book allowance which shall be released by the Regional Office to the RSTC/COE where the teacher is enrolled. A training fee of Eight Thousand Pesos (PhP8,000.00) per participant is also paid to the training institution.

6. Per DepED Memorandum No. 345, s. 2006, Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) other than the Regional Science Teaching Centers (RSTCs) and Centers of Excellence (COEs) wishing to offer the Certificate Program should coordinate with the Regional Office. To qualify: a) the TEI should offer BSEd major in the sciences or mathematics; b) 75% of its faculty should have completed graduate studies in Science/Mathematics teaching/education; c) it should have adequate and functional laboratories/resources; and d) programs in Science/Mathematics teaching/education should have passed Level II accreditation. If the latter requirement cannot be satisfied, the TEI is encouraged to offer the program in collaboration with an RSTC or COE.

- 7. The outline of courses may be requested by the TEI from SEI-DOST. The final list of participants who shall be enrolled in the Summer Certificate Program as well as the other supporting documents (for the items required in the above provision) shall form part of the recommendation to the Undersecretary for Regional Operations for the approval of the TEI to offer the Certificate Program.
- 8. Per DepED Memorandum No. 127, s. 2007, the Regional Office shall coordinate with the RSTCs/COEs relative to Program implementation.
- 9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
