NATIONAL ORIENTATION FOR ADOPT-A-SCHOOL PROGRAM COORDINATORS

1. In view of the designation of all Assistant Schools Division Superintendents as ASP Coordinators at the division level (please refer to DepED Memorandum No. 106, s. 2007), a national orientation shall be conducted as follows:

- 2. The objective of this activity is to orient the ASP Coordinators at the region and division levels on their roles and responsibilities under the Adopt-A-School Program. At the end of the orientation, each participant shall be preparing their respective action plans. Specifically, participants are expected to be:
 - acquainted with the Master Plan (2007-2010) of ASP and how it relates with the thrust of the Department;
 - equipped with an understanding of how they can contribute to the attainment of the thrusts and targets of ASP; and
 - familiarized with the monitoring and evaluation system.
- 3. These orientation activities shall be attended by ASP Regional Coordinators (see enclosed list) and Assistant Schools Division Superintendents (ASDS). Each regional coordinator is expected to prepare a presentation on their region's accomplishments for 2006, as well as lessons learned, facilitating and hindering factors, and action plans for 2007 in relation to Adopt-A-School Program activities. These reports shall be shared and submitted during the orientation.

- 4. Participants are expected to check-in at the venue early morning of Day 1 of the dates indicated above. Breakfast shall be served to the participants while program shall start at 9:00 a.m. of that same day. Please refer to the enclosed program. Check-out time shall be in the afternoon of Day 3.
- 5. Transportation expenses of regional and division participants shall be charged to regional and division funds respectively. On the other hand, training cost which includes food and accommodation of participants and training team, and training kits and materials shall be drawn from OSEC funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
