- a. assist DepED in initiating and formulating strategies, policies and guidelines pertaining to the conceptualization, process, implementation, monitoring and evaluation phase of the strengthened tech-voc education program;
- b. assist the DepED Tech-Voc Task Force and be consulted in crafting the proper approach in strengthening the technical-vocational training infrastructure, facilities and other relevant assistance for the strengthened tech-voc education program of the Department;
- c. assist DepED in establishing partnership/linkages and coordinate with prospective stakeholders for the implementation and sustenance of the tech-voc secondary education;
- d. guide on issues, options and directions of the strengthened tech-voc education program; and
- e. closely work and coordinate with the DepED Tech-Voc Education Task Force on specific program components of the strengthened TVE program with respect to curriculum design and development, tech-voc teachers and management trainings, infrastructure, facilities, textbooks and instructional materials, and policy support.
- 3. All expenses relative to the functions of the Advisory Council shall be charged to the following: to OSEC Funds on the activities of this Advisory Council, and to Human Resource Funds on the curriculum writeshop and teachers trainings subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
