INTEL® TEACH 2007 SUMMER ACTIVITIES

To: Regional Directors

Schools Division/City Superintendents Heads, Public Secondary Schools

- 1. One of the major directions of Philippine education is the integration of Information Technology in Secondary Education. To assist teachers in building their capacity, Intel® Technology Philippines, Inc. (ITPI), in coordination with the Department of Education (DepED), UP National Institute for Science and Mathematics Education Development (UP NISMED), and Foundation for Information Technology Education Development, Inc. (FIT-ED), shall conduct the following activities in April and July 2007.
- 2. The 10-day Intel® Teach National Training Program aims to:
 - a. enhance participants' competencies in developing 21st century teaching and learning approaches, such as student-centered instruction, critical thinking, and collaboration through the Intel Teach Program's Getting Started Course and Skills for Success Course; and
 - b. prepare them to conduct the same training in the regions and in their own schools. As such, their activities will be considered **official** business.
- 3. The training will be conducted in two batches, with dates and venues as follows:

4. Participants shall be notified thru their Regional IT Coordinator on the final arrangement of the venue and accommodation for Batches 2A and 2B.

- 5. Participants to the Intel® Teach National Training Program will be selected by UP NISMED in coordination with DepED-BSE. Participants are listed in the enclosure.
- 6. The selected participants shall confirm their attendance two weeks before the activity with their Regional IT Coordinator or with Ms. Ma. Elsie C. Esmer/Mr. Edward Garcia, SDD-BSE at telefax no. (02) 632-7586. Participants are expected to be at the workshop venue a day before the start of the activity.
- 7. UP NISMED shall be the trainers for Batch 1, while trainers trained in Batch 1 will co-train Batches 2A and 2B.
- 8. Arrangement for the accommodation, meals, and transportation is as follows: Intel® shall pay for the meals, accommodation, and the training fee, while traveling expenses of the participants shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 9. Participants to the Intel® Teach National Training Program are all expected to conduct a school-based training for 20 other teachers in their respective schools, and conduct at least one batch of regional training.
- 10. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
