- 4. Applicants should possess the following basic qualifications:
 - a. Must have a degree in Science or Mathematics education;
 - b. Must have a minimum teaching experience of five (5) years;
 - c. Must not have availed of a similar training or scholarship program in the last two
 (2) years;
 - d. Must be in excellent health;
 - e. Must not be more than fifty (50) years of age at the time of availment of the scholarship:
 - f. Must have knowledge of basic computer application programs;
 - g. Must be a LET or PBET passer/eligible and with a permanent appointment; and
 - h. Must be good at spoken and written English to get the maximum benefit from the course.
- 5. The submission of nominations together with the nominees' transcript of records, performance ratings for the last three (3) years, latest service record, medical certificate fro a government medical officer, certification of no pending administrative or criminal case, photocopy of baccalaureate diploma, certification of English proficiency, personal data sheet (CS Form 212) and endorsement from the Regional Director shall be guided by the following deadlines:
