BPI SEARCH FOR 10 OUTSTANDING EXPAT PINOY CHILDREN

Regional Directors City/Schools Division Superintendents Heads of Private and Public Schools/Colleges/Universities

- 1. Expat Pinoys are truly deserving of their titles as the country's modern heroes as they showcase endearing characteristics of Filipinos, bringing honor to the country through the diligence and resourcefulness they demonstrate in their work. They help tremendously in the progress of the Philippines through their earnings and remittances.
- 2. The Bank of Philippine Islands (BPI) has long recognized the importance of Expat Pinoys to the society, hence, the launch of the Search for 10 Outstanding Expat Pinoy Children. The search aims to:
 - a) help Expat Pinoys' children realize the magnitude of their parents' contribution to the country at present and in the future;
 - b) inspire the children to achieve their dreams which are the driving force of their parents' sacrifices and endless diligence;
 - c) serve as an added motivation to Expat Pinoys and validation as parents see their children excel and be honored in a prestigious
 - d) reach out to the public's consciousness to fully grasp the value of the community of the Expat Pinoys and their families.
- 3. A cash prize of P50,000.00 is at stake for the search. The search is open to children of Expat Pinoys (OFWs)15 to 21 years old who can meet
 - a) Has parents or relatives who must be BPI depositors and must have a current contract with a foreign country;
 - b) Children must belong to the top 10% of their class, level or batch
 - c) Children must be presently enrolled or can be a graduate of a fouryear course but no more than two years past.
- 4. The nominee must submit the following requirements:
 - a) Accomplished Application form
 - b) Certified true copy of grades including list of awards from school

- c) Proof of enrolment in the current school year (e.g. registration form), or a diploma or certificate of graduation from the college or
- d) Birth certificate or proof of relation to the Expat Pinoy (OFW);
- e) Certification from BPI Branch Head, indicating that a member of his/her family has an account with BPI;
- f) Letter of nomination from the school principal, district supervisor, college dean, managers of BPI or BPI Family Savings Bank; Parish Priest or head of a civil or church organization (forms are available for free at all branches of BPI or BPI Family Savings Bank, or may be downloaded from www.bpiexpressonline.com.ph; and www.bpidirect.com.ph).
- g) An essay answering the question "Ano ang papel ko sa pagpapaunlad ng ating pamayanan bilang anak ng isang Expat Pinoy?" (What is my role in the development of our society, as a son/daughter of an Expat Pinoy?) The essay can be written in English or Filipino; type-written, double spaced and must have between 1,500 to 2,000 words which will be judged based on the following:

- 7. Announcement of winners will be in August 2007 during the 156^{th} anniversary of BPI. All winners will be notified through mail.
