A CALL TO ALL DEPED-CENTRAL OFFICE EMPLOYEES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 2007 BRIGADA ESKWELA: NATIONAL SCHOOL MAINTENANCE WEEK

- 1. The Brigada Eskwela is a nationwide school maintenance program of the Department that aims to engage all education stakeholders to contribute their time, efforts, and resources in ensuring that public school facilities are all set in time for class opening this June.
- 2. In last year's Brigada Eskwela, more than 29,000 schools participated generating a total of 2B savings for the Department. Because of the program's positive results, the number of schools to participate in this year's Brigada Eskwela is targeted to increase significantly.
- 3. In line with this, all DepED employees are encouraged to get involved by doing voluntary works in public schools in areas near their residence for the period May 21-26, 2007. Interested employees can serve in their selected schools for 1 day only and should secure the approval of their directors or chiefs or office heads to be considered on **official time**.
- 4. Original copies of Certificates of Appearance signed by the School Heads or Principals must be submitted to their respective superiors and to the Personnel Division upon reporting back to Central Office.
- 5. All heads of offices are enjoined to observe proper scheduling among employees in order to ensure non-disruption of regular functions and operations.

6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
