109th ANNIVERSARY OF THE PROCLAMATION OF PHILIPPINE INDEPENDENCE

- The 109th Anniversary of the Proclamation of Philippine Independence will be commemorated from May 28 (The National Flag Day) to June 30, 2007. This is a collaborative task of all the government agencies, private sectors, non-government associations and organizations. The theme of this year's celebration is "Sama-Sama Tayo Tungo Sa Pag-Asenso."
- The objectives of this year's celebration are to: 2.
 - a. Reawaken the Filipinos of their responsibility and patriotic commitment especially the youth to commemorate the heroism, nationalism and selfsacrifice of our forefathers in the struggle for independence;
 - b. Instill in our minds the greatness of our race, the legacy of our heroes and the ideals of nationhood; and
 - c. Unite and rally behind the government's Ten Point Agenda to "BEAT THE ODDS" and the country's' institutions.
- As co-chairman of the 2007 National Organizing Committee (NOC), the Secretary with the DepED officials (national, regional, divisions), teachers and students will actively participate in the scheduled programs and activities which are divided into three modules namely: The Watawat and Pambansang Awit Module (May 21 to June 4), The Kalayaan Module (June 5 to 15), and the Kabayanihan Module (June 16 to 30).
- All DepED offices and schools, both public and private are hereby requested to display and raise the Flag from May 21 to June 30 to support the National Flag Day. Also, significant events in history that lead to the proclamation of independence be taken up in classroom discussions especially in Social Studies, English, Filipino, Values, and MAPEH.
- Some of the highlights of the celebration are the awarding ceremonies of the 3rd Pambansang Gawad sa Ulirang Kabataan and the Launching of the Walk for LIFE (Leadership In Filipino Education) under the Kalayaan Module on June 11, the Rizal Is Alive Forum and the Grand Raffle Draw of the Rizal National Festival of Excellence tickets on June 19 as part of the Kabayanihan Module.

- 6. The transportation/travel expenses of the awardees (17) and the Regional Special Events Coordinators or their alternates (17) shall be charged against local funds. All other preparatory and actual expenses—shall be charged against OSEC funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Expenses for the awards, plaques, medals, service bus/van for the participants, honoraria of the board and panel of judges and emcee shall be charged against NHI 2007 Independence Day funds.
- 7. Enclosed is the DepED program of activities from May 21 to June 30, 2007. The list of the National Events will follow.
