

- 1. On April 10-11, 2007, a Consultative Conference on the Strengthened Tech-Voc Education Program was conducted at the Marikina Hotel, Marikina City for purposes of validating the regional ranking of tech-voc high schools to be prioritized for the initial implementation of the Program, and coming up with a final comprehensive/updated database of tech-voc high schools, among others.
- 2. As an offshoot of collaborative efforts with SEAMEO-INNOTECH and the field offices of the Department, the Task Force has finally come up with an initial list of the one hundred forty (140) priority tech-voc high schools to offer the technical-vocational education competency-based curriculum.
