DISTRIBUTION OF THE TEACHING EXEMPLARS IN GIRAFT AND CORRUPTION PREVENTION IN EDUCATION (GCPE) TO IDENTIFIED PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS;

TO: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
District Supervisors

- 1. Background on the GCPE Beginning 2004, the Office of the Ombudsman and the Department of Education (DepED) worked together to update the teaching exemplars in Graft and Corruption Prevention Education (GCPE) for use of public elementary and secondary schools nationwide. The teaching exemplars are instructional materials that support the curricula that highlight the importance of integrity in all aspects of national life, as well as, the value of anti-corruption in good governance and public service. With funding support from the European Commission, technical assistance from the Millennium Challenge Corporation Philippines Threshold Program (MCA-PTP), and the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), more than 200,000 copies of the teaching exemplars were printed. The Office of the Ombudsman and DeptED are now ready to distribute the GCPE teaching exemplars to all public elementary and secondary schools nationwide.
- 2. In compliance with the provisions stipulated in the Joint Declaration of Undertaking between the Department of Education (DepED) and the Office of the Ombudsman (OMB) on the GCPE project, the revised copy off the GCPE Teaching Exemplars will be distributed to the identiffied public elementary and secondary schools through the DepED district offices. The district supervisors, central school principals, and district property custodians are the authorized receiving personnel of the anti-corruption teaching exemplars.
- 3. The District Supervisors are advised to give the copy of the teaching exemplars to the principals of the identified public elementary and public secondary schools within their jurisdiction. In turn, the principals shall give the copy off the teaching exemplars to the Araling Panlipunan (Makabayam) and Values Education Teachers who will implement the GCPE modules in all grade/year lewels in public elementary and secondary schools in the district.
- 4. The District Supervisors must ask each principal to sign a monitoring report upon receipt of the GCPE teaching exemplars. Please use the attached sample monitoring report (Attachment A). Once the distributtion is completed and the

monitoring sheet duly accomplished, the District Supervisors are directed to fax the duly accomplished monitoring sheet to the following:

- 5. Upon receipt of the GCPE teaching exemplars, each district is given 2 month's to distribute the exemplars to the identified public schools.
- 6. Only limited copies are allotted for each school. To ensure that enough copies are available, the principals are advised to photocopy or reproduce copies for all the teachers who will use and apply the GCPE teaching exemplairs. - 7. To ensure that the teaching exemplars are distributed and are being justed by the identified public elementary and secondary schools, a monitoring team composed of representatives from the DepED BEE and BSE, Ombudsman, USAID and the MCA-PTP project will visit the recipient districts and public schools between July and August 2007.
