TWENTY-SEVENTH NATIONAL SECONDARY SCHOOL  
ADMINISTRATORS CONGRESS

1. The Philippine Association of Secondary School Administrators (PASSA) in coordination with the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), announces the holding of the **27<sup>th</sup> National Secondary School Administrators Congress** on September 4-6, 2007 at the Iloilo Grand Hotel, Iloilo City, with the theme "Holistic Education for All: The School Administrator Setting the Pace".
2. The congress aims to:
  - a. apprise the participants of the basic and nuances of integration and holistic education in relation to academic and technical vocational lines;
  - b. enable the participants to arrive at an implementation framework towards a core secondary curriculum for academic and technical vocational education; and
  - c. prepare the participants for a stronger sensitivity to the needs of the students in various and specific contexts.
3. Participants to this Congress are private and public school principals/assistant principals, teachers-in-charge (TICs) or Officers-in-Charge (OICs), administrators, superintendents and assistant superintendents, regional and division supervisors in charge of secondary education, supervisors in charge of alternative learning system, chiefs and assistant chiefs of Secondary Education Divisions and heads of secondary trade-agriculture-fisheries schools. Attendance to this Congress shall be on official business.
4. A registration fee of Four Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP4,500.00) shall be charged each participant including working committee members to cover board and lodging, materials and other related conference expenses. Meals shall be served from the supper of September 3 until lunch of September 6. Members of the different committees, as well as the present PASSA officials and Board of Directors are authorized to travel two days before the Congress. Traveling expenses and registration fee shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
