ORACLE DATABASE TECHNOLOGY ENHANCEMENT TRAINING

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Secondary Schools

1. The Oracle (Philippines) Corporation in collaboration with this Department shall conduct the 5-week on-line **Oracle Database Technology Enhancement Training** from August 20 to September 21, 2007.

2. The training aims to enhance the skills of the pilot teachers on database technology for integration into the high school curriculum in preparation for the implementation of the DepED-Oracle Database Technology Program.

3. Participants in the aforementioned training are the fifty-six (56) teachers from the thirty (30) pilot public high schools of the Program who have participated in the pre-institute trainings in October 2006 and January 2007.
