## ANNUAL SEMINAR-CONVENTION IN HOME ECONOMICS

- 1. The Philippine Home Economics Association (PHEA), will hold a three-day Annual Seminar-Convention in Home Economics (EPP-TLE) on October 26-28, 2007 at Grand Men Seng Hotel, Magallanes, Davao City.
- 2. The theme of the convention is "Reorienting Human Capital in Home Economics: Meeting Current and Future Challenges". The theme will focus on the effort to optimize the productive and efficiency of the human capital in the field of home economics. The PHEA hopes to explore the potential and generation of efficient human capital to be an efficient, creative, innovative home economist.
- 3. Participants to the convention are regional and division supervisors, principals and school heads of Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) and Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan (EPP), TLE chairman and coordinators, EPP teachers, Agriculture and Industrial Arts teachers, DepED-TLE scholars representing their respective regions, regional PHEA coordinators and PHEA regional, division and school level officers. Participants are advised to bring their PHEA Identification Cards.
- 4. Attendance of the participants shall be on official time only. A registration fee of Three Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Pesos (PhP3,850.00) shall be charged each participant to cover expenses for food and hotel accommodation which starts 1:00 p.m. of October 26 and ends 5:00 p.m. after the city tour of October 28, 2007, conference kits, certificates, medals/trophies, instructional materials, resource persons' tour and other incidental expenses.
